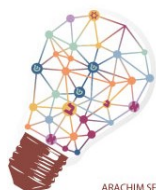

- What changes do you want to take forward and how can you be helped to make this happen?



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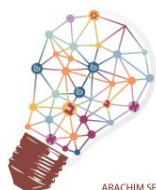

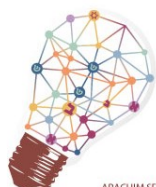
